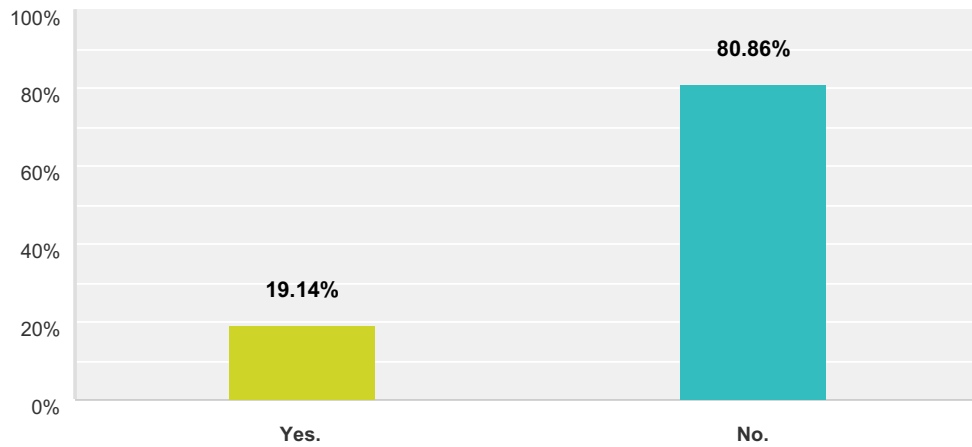


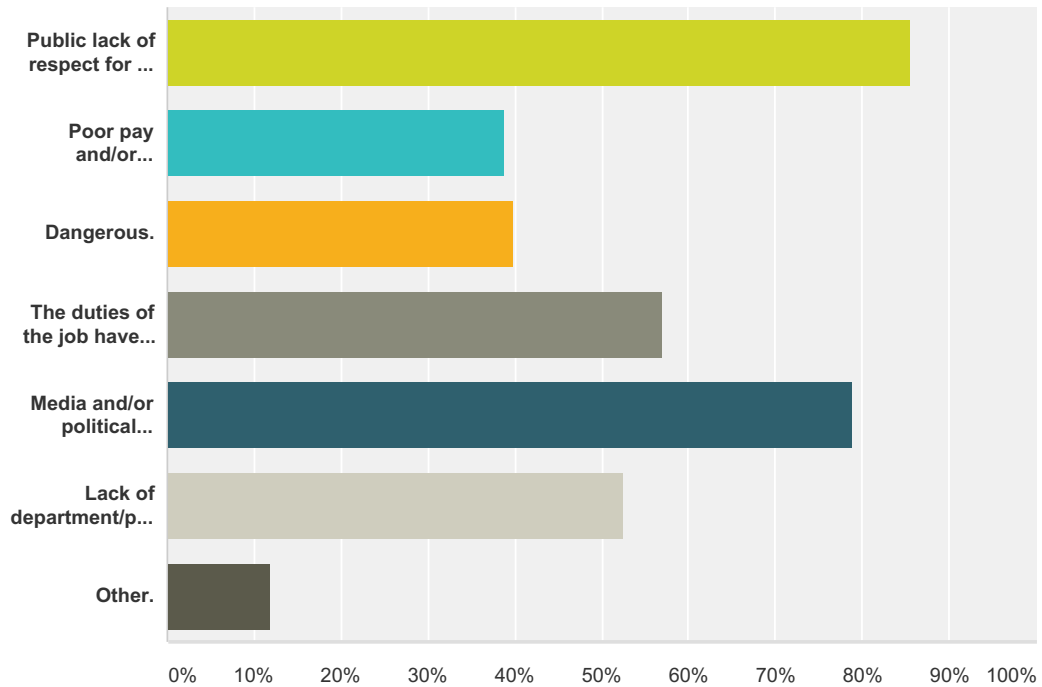
### Q1 Would you encourage a son or daughter to go into law enforcement as a career?

Answered: 2,815 Skipped: 640



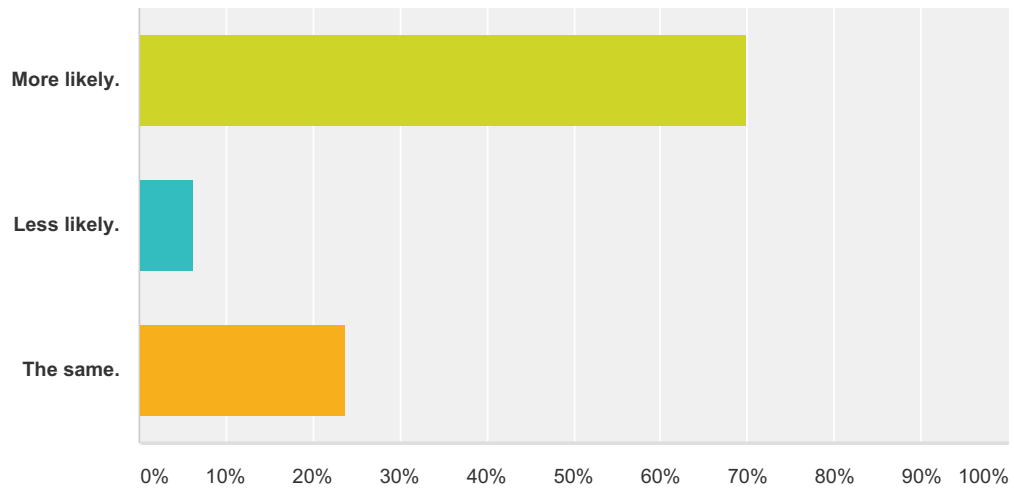

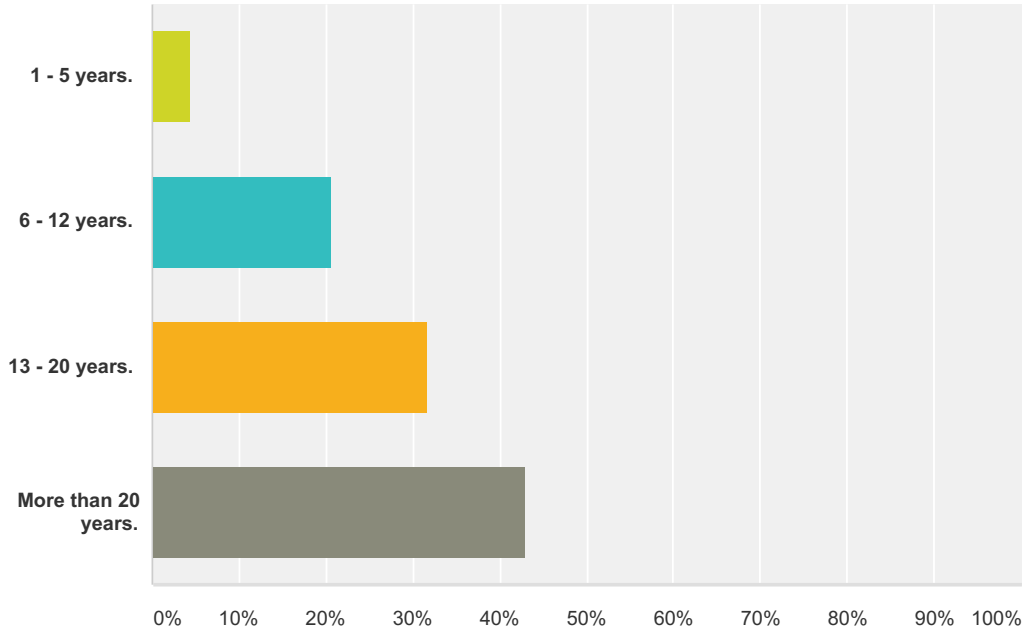

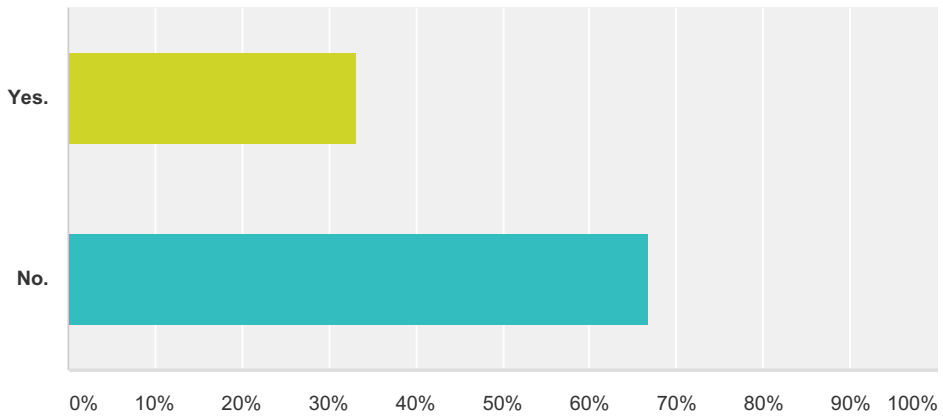
